This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 1307:2014+A3:2018. It supersedes BS EN 1307:2014+A2:2018, which is withdrawn.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to CEN text carry the number of the CEN amendment. For example, text altered by CEN amendment A1 is indicated by $\boxed{\mathbb{A}}$ $\boxed{\mathbb{A}}$.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PRI/3, Textile floor coverings.

BSI, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN 1307:2014+A3:2018 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that during the development of this European Standard, the UK committee voted against its approval as a European Standard.

The national committee have commented on, and voted against, this standard at all stages up to and including Formal Vote. They have concerns about the ability of the standard to correctly classify textile carpets.

Specifically, different end use classes rely on half grade delineation of appearance retention assessment which the relevant standard itself states is outside the expected variability. The comment applies to all the floor coverings covered by this standard.

This publication does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users are responsible for its correct application.
