This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 60335-2-15:2016+A12:2021 incorporating EN 60335-2-15:2016+A1:2021, and EN 60335-2-15:2016+A2:2021. It is derived from IEC 60335-2-15:2012 incorporating amendment 1:2016 and amendment 2:2018. It supersedes BS EN 60335-2-15:2016+A11:2018, which will be withdrawn on 1 October 2024.

The CENELEC common modifications have been implemented at the appropriate places in the text. The start and finish of each common modification is indicated in the text by tags **[C]** **[C]**.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to the text carry the number of the CENELEC amendment. For example, text altered by CENELEC amendment A11 is indicated by **[A11]** **[A11]** and text altered by CENELEC amendment A12 is indicated by **[A12]** **[A12]**.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to IEC text carry the number of the IEC amendment. For example, text altered by IEC amendment 1 is indicated by **[A1]** **[A1]** and text altered by IEC amendment 2 is indicated by **[A2]** **[A2]**.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CPL/61/7, Safety of electrical appliances - Heated appliance group.
