It is derived from IEC 60335-2-23:2003, incorporating amendment 1:2008 and amendment 2:2012, and corrigenda July 2004 and January 2008. It supersedes BS EN 60335-2-23:2003+A11:2010, which will be withdrawn on 29 September 2017.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to IEC text carry the number of the IEC amendment. For example, text altered by IEC amendment 1 is indicated by A.

Where a common modification to an IEC amendment has been introduced, the tags carry the number of the amendment. For example, the common modifications introduced by CENELEC to IEC amendment 2 are indicated by $\boxed{\mathbb{C}_2}$ $\boxed{\mathbb{C}_2}$.

Where a common modification has been introduced by CENELEC amendment, the tags carry the number of the amendment. For example, the common modifications introduced by CENELEC amendment A11 are indicated by C_{11} C_{11} .
