This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 60335-2-16:2003+A11:2018. It is derived from IEC 60335-2-16:2002, incorporating amendments 1:2008 and 2:2011. It supersedes BS EN 60335-2-16:2003+A2:2012, which will be withdrawn on 17 August 2021.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to IEC text carry the number of the IEC amendment. For example, text altered by IEC amendment 1 is indicated by A1 A1. Text altered by CENELEC amendment A11 is indicated by A11 A11.

The CENELEC common modifications have been implemented at the appropriate places in the text. The start and finish of each common modification is indicated in the text by tags C C.
