This standard has been prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 219 “Floor coverings” of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and has been taken over as EN ISO 24345:2012 by Technical Committee CEN/TC 134 “Resilient, textile and laminate floor coverings”, (Secretariat: BSI, United Kingdom).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was the *Normenausschuss Kunststoffe* (Plastics Standards Committee), Working Committee NA 054-04-05 AA *Bodenbeläge*.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 431:1994-11 as follows:

- a) in the German version *Trennwiderstand* has been replaced with *Schälwiderstand*;
- b) Clause 5 “Sampling and selection of specimens” has been modified;
- c) Clause 7 “Test procedure” has been modified;
- d) Clause 8 “Calculation and expression of results” has been revised;
- e) Clause 10 “Test report” has been extended;
- f) the title of the standard has been changed.
