National foreword

This document (EN 1022:2018) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 207 “Furniture” (Secretariat: UNI, Italy).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Holzwirtschaft und Möbel* (DIN Standards Committee Timber and Furniture), Working Committee NA 042-05-15 AA “Seating, upholstered furniture and tables (national mirror committee for CEN/TC 207/WG 1, WG 5 and WG 9, ISO/TC 136/WG 1 and WG 2”).

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 1022:2005-09 as follows:

- a) the title and Scope of this document have been amended to include seating for all uses;
- b) all test methods for the assessment of the stability of seating used in European Standards for furniture have been combined in this standard, which now includes methods that have been previously listed in DIN EN 1022, DIN EN 581-2, *Outdoor furniture*, and DIN EN 1335-3, *Office work chairs*;
- c) the test methods for the assessment of the stability of office work chairs and all other seating have been harmonized;
- d) a test method for the assessment of the corner stability has been introduced for all types of chair.
