- *Part 2: Children’s harnesses incorporating backpacks and reins — Safety requirements and test methods*

### **Amendments**

This standard differs from DIN EN 13210:2004-11 as follows:

- a) the standard has been subdivided into two parts; Part 1 covers children’s harnesses and reins; Part 2 includes children’s harnesses incorporating backpacks and reins;
- b) the document has been redesigned in a hazard-based format;
- c) the direction of the force has been changed from vertical to horizontal in the tests on mechanical hazards;
- d) the standard has been editorially revised.
