European Standard EN 14183 : 2003 has the status of a DIN Standard.*A comma is used as the decimal marker.*

This standard includes safety requirements within the meaning of the *Gerätesicherheitsgesetz* (German Equipment Safety Law).

National foreword

This standard has been prepared by CEN/TC 93 'Ladders' (Secretariat: Germany).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was the *Normenausschuss Holzwirtschaft und Möbel* (Timber and Furniture Standards Committee).

Step stools as specified in this standard fall within the scope of the *Gerätesicherheitsgesetz*. Once compliance with the safety requirements specified therein has been verified by an accredited test house designated by the *Bundesminister für Wirtschaft und Arbeit* (German Federal Minister of Labour and Economics), the step stool may be marked with the symbol *GS* (= *geprüfte Sicherheit*, safety tested).
