National foreword

This standard includes safety requirements within the meaning of the *Produktsicherheitsgesetz (ProdSG)* (German Product Safety Act).

This document (EN 1176-2:2017+AC:2019) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 136 “Sports, playground and other recreational facilities and equipment” (Secretariat: DIN, Germany).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Sport- und Freizeitgerät* (DIN Standards Committee Sports Equipment), Working Committee NA 112-07-01 AA “Playground equipment”.

Where this standard has been identified by the *Ausschuss für Produktsicherheit* (German Committee for Product Safety) and reference to it has been published in the *Gemeinsames Ministerialblatt* (German Joint Ministerial Gazette) by the *Bundesanstalt für Arbeitsschutz und Arbeitsmedizin (BAuA)* (German Federal Institute for Occupational Safety and Health), it is to be presumed that cableways which comply with this standard fulfil the relevant health and safety requirements. A transition period which might be specified in the start of application of this document is not a critical factor for the effectiveness of such presumption of conformity.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 1176-4:2008-10 and DIN EN 1176-4 Corrigendum 1:2008-12 as follows:

- a) the finger test for the traveller has been added;
- b) the requirements for ground clearance for seating type cableways have been amended;
- c) the test weight has been changed.

Compared with DIN EN 1176-4:2017-12, the following corrections have been made:

- a) details regarding the Amendments have been updated in the National foreword and in the European foreword;
- b) the first sentence in the Scope has been rendered more precise.
