This standard includes safety requirements.

This document (EN 13209-2:2015) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 252 “Child use and care articles” (Secretariat: AFNOR, France).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Sicherheitstechnische Grundsätze* (DIN Standards Committee Safety Design Principles), Working Committee NA 095-05-03 AA *Artikel für Säuglinge und Kleinkinder — Sitzen, Pflegen, Schützen, Liegen und Transportieren*.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 13209-2:2005-11 as follows:

- a) conditioning of the test piece for testing has been specified;
- b) hazards have been subdivided into thermal hazards (Clause 7) and mechanical hazards (Clause 8);
- c) the mechanical hazards clause has been subdivided into choking and ingestion hazards (8.1), entanglement hazards (8.2), protective functions (8.3), and general requirements for attachment systems (8.4), and the relevant test methods have been specified;
- d) the test method for the accessibility of fillings has been deleted;
- e) the requirements for packaging materials (Clause 9) have been revised;
- f) a new Annex A giving translations of warnings has been added;
- g) a new Annex B giving rationales for the inclusion of some of the requirements given in this standard has been added.
