National foreword

This document (EN 14682:2014) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 248 “Textiles and textile products” (Secretariat: BSI, United Kingdom).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was the *DIN-Normenausschuss Textil und Textilmaschinen* (DIN Standards Committee Textiles and Textile Machinery), Working Committee NA 106-01-02 *AA Textilien und Bekleidung – Kennzeichnung, Anforderungen und Prüfverfahren*.

This standard includes safety requirements within the meaning of the European Commission Mandate No. M/309 “The Safety of Consumers: drawstrings or cords on children’s clothing”, issued 9 March 2001.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 14682:2008-02 as follows:

- a) Clause 1 “Scope” bags and purses that are often sold as co-ordinating accessories for children’s clothing have been included;
- b) Clause 2 “Terms and definitions” has been restructured and extended;
- c) “2.10 belt (excluding tied belts)” has been added, to differentiate from tied belt;
- d) “2.11 tied belt or sash” has been revised;
- e) “2.12 braces (suspenders)” has been added;
- f) “2.19 open to its largest and laid flat” has been added;
- g) “2.20 relaxed natural state” has been added;
- h) “2.21 three dimensional embellishment” has been added;
- i) “2.22 hood neck and upper chest” has been changed to “head, neck and upper chest area”;
- j) in Clause 3 “Requirements”, Subclause 3.1.4, a NOTE has been included to consider functional hanger loops;
- k) in Subclauses 3.2 and 3.3, the term “hood” has been deleted and replaced by “head”;
- l) Subclause 3.4 has been revised;
- m) Subclause 3.7 has been revised to consider strings other than at hems, and all lengths of sleeve;
- n) in Annex B, a new paragraph has been added to clarify that anthropometric data listed is that used to define children’s sizes in EN 14682:2004, where the tallest children in Europe were considered;
- o) Annex C has been extended to provide rationale for exclusions from scope, and rationale for requirements for lengths of drawstrings and cords;
- p) in Annex D, new improved methods of measurement have been added;

- q) in Annex F, improved figures have been included to illustrate the requirements;
- r) to assist the reader, throughout this European Standard, the terms defined in Clause 2 “Terms and definitions” are in italics.
