This document (EN 1972:2015) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 136 "Sports, playground and other recreational facilities and equipment" (Secretariat: DIN, Germany).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Sport- und Freizeitgerät* (DIN Standards Committee Sports Equipment), Working Committee NA 112-05-05 AA *Tauch-Zubehör*.

Where this standard has been identified by the *Ausschuss für Produktsicherheit* (German Committee for Product Safety) and reference to it has been published in the *Gemeinsames Ministerialblatt* (German Joint Ministerial Gazette) by the *Bundesanstalt für Arbeitsschutz und Arbeitsmedizin (BAuA)* (German Federal Institute for Occupational Safety and Health), it is to be presumed that snorkels which comply with this standard fulfil the relevant health and safety requirements.

#### **Amendments**

This standard differs from DIN EN 1972:1997-09 as follows:

- a) the definitions of snorkel and mouthpiece have been updated;
- b) classes A and B have been defined for the snorkel dimensions;
- c) requirements for shut-off valves have been added;
- d) new test methods such as visual inspection, tests for dimensions, resistance to air flow, joint strength and practical performance have been introduced or updated;
- e) requirements for marking have been specified;
- f) requirements regarding the information to be supplied by the manufacturer have been specified.
