National foreword

This standard includes safety requirements within the meaning of the *Produktsicherheitsgesetz (ProdSG)* (German Product Safety Act).

This document (EN 716-1:2017+AC:2019) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 207 “Furniture” (Secretariat: UNI, Italy).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Holzwirtschaft und Möbel* (DIN Standards Committee Timber and Furniture), Working Committee NA 42-05-13 AA “Requirements for children's furniture, national mirror committee for CEN/TC 207/WG 2, CEN/TC 364, ISO/TC 136/WG 6”.

Where this standard has been identified by the *Ausschuss für Produktsicherheit* (German Committee for Product Safety) and reference to it has been published in the *Gemeinsames Ministerialblatt* (German Joint Ministerial Gazette) by the *Bundesanstalt für Arbeitsschutz und Arbeitsmedizin (BAuA)* (German Federal Institute for Occupational Safety and Health), it is to be presumed that children's cots and folding cots which comply with this standard fulfil the relevant health and safety requirements.

This standard includes Corrigendum 1 approved by CEN on 6 March 2019.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 716-1:2013-03 as follows:

- a) elements of the corrigendum have been included;
- b) 4.4.8.1 “Movable sides” has been clarified;
- c) 4.4.8.2 “Distance between footholds and top of cot sides and ends” has been modified;
- d) Clause 6 “Instructions for use” has been updated;
- e) a warning concerning the risk when adding a second mattress in the bed has been included;
- f) Clause 7 “Marking” has been amended.

Compared with DIN EN 716-1:2017-08, the following corrections have been made:

- a) EN 716-1:2017+AC:2019 has been incorporated. This corrigendum includes clarification on the permitted distance between footholds and the top of the children's cot;
- b) 4.4.4.3 “Shear and squeeze points during use”: the translation has been corrected (applies to the German version only);
- c) Warnings a) and b) in Clause 6 “Instructions for use” have been adapted to the reference version (applies to the German version only);
- d) the standard has been editorially revised.
