This document (EN 1335-2:2018) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 207 “Furniture” (Secretariat: UNI, Italy).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Holzwirtschaft und Möbel* (DIN Standards Committee Timber and Furniture), Working Committee NA 042-05-19 AA “Requirements for office furniture, national mirror committee for CEN/TC 207/WG 3, ISO/TC 136/WG 1 and WG 2”.

This standard includes safety requirements within the meaning of the *Produktsicherheitsgesetz (ProdSG)* (German Product Safety Act).

Where this standard has been identified by the *Ausschuss für Produktsicherheit* (German Committee for Product Safety) and reference to it has been published in the *Gemeinsames Ministerialblatt* (German Joint Ministerial Gazette) by the *Bundesanstalt für Arbeitsschutz und Arbeitsmedizin (BAuA)* (German Federal Institute for Occupational Safety and Health), it is to be presumed that office work chairs which comply with this standard fulfil the relevant health and safety requirements.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 1335-2:2010-01 and DIN EN 1335-3:2009-08 as follows:

- a) normative references have been amended: references to EN 1335-3:2009 have been replaced by references to EN 1022:2018 and EN 1728:2012;
- b) further terms have been defined;
- c) safety requirements have been rendered more precise with regard to shear and squeeze points;
- d) a test report has been added;
- e) Annex A (normative) has been incorporated in the normative text;
- f) a new Annex A (informative) for the functional test of the chair has been added.
