Amendments

- a) the erroneous German title of this standard has been corrected by deleting the word “*abgepassten*” and by removing the “*Pol*” from the word “*Polteppiche*”;
- b) three of the normative references have been updated;
- c) the standard has been editorially revised and brought in line with the current rules of presentation.
