Standard Size of Chairs for Office

1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the standard size and dimensions of respective parts of the chairs for office, hereinafter referred to as the "chairs".

- Remarks
1. The chairs for office mean the chairs for business to be used in general business.
 2. The units and numerical values given in { } in this standard are in accordance with the International System of Units (SI), and are appended for reference.

2. Reference Planes of Chair

The chair shall be provided with the following reference planes:

- (1) With respect to the width direction and depth direction, reference planes are provided respectively in vertical direction, contacting with the planes of the maximum profiles excluding legs.
- (2) With respect to the height direction, reference planes are provided respectively in a plane contacting with the floor and in a floor surface of the maximum height including legs.

3. Reference Points of Chair

3.1 The chair shall be provided with a reference point for seating position and a back-rest point.

3.2 The seating reference point and the back-rest point shall be as given in Table 1.
