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Office furniture-steel chairs

1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies office furniture-steel chairs (hereafter referred to as the "chairs") corresponding to JIS S 1031.

- Remarks 1. Herein a chair is such that the structural members, such as legs, are made of steel materials or other metal materials, and a seat and assembly type are included. Folding chairs with a writing arm are not included.
2. Standards cited in this Standard are shown in Attached Table 1.
3. The units and numerical values given in { } in this Standard are based on the traditional units and are appended for informative reference.

2. Quality

2.1 Appearance The appearance shall be as follows:

- (1) The finish shall be good, and free from significant defects, such as misaligned junctions, etc.
- (2) The parts in contact with the body and clothes shall be free from sharp protrusions, corners, etc.
- (3) The face side of parts with a painted surface shall be uniform in gloss and color tone, and shall be free from uneven painting, sagging, etc.

2.2 Performance The performance shall be subjected to the testing specified in 7., and shall comply with the specifications of Table 1.
